The Alexandra Yacht Club is a “self-help” club. What does this mean? It means that each member takes pride and responsibility in maintaining our club. As a guest, feel free to approach and ask any member for help, assistance or questions about the club. Our members are knowledgeable about our area, transportation, services and things to do. We welcome the opportunity to meet you and make your stay with us a memorable one.

Reciprocal Club Visitors

As a member of a recognized “Reciprocal Club”, you are welcome to stay and moor your vessel for **two nights without charge**.

What YOU should do when you arrive!

Arrival during morning or afternoon hours:

- Pilot your vessel to the sea wall east of the main docks (look for the mast crane located in the south-east corner of the basin).
- Safely tie-off your vessel and the Officer-of-the-Day (OOD) will meet you.
- The OOD will confirm that you are a member of a recognized Reciprocal Club and have you sign our “Visitor’s Log” and advise/assign you an

available mooring (should one for your vessel be available). Note: the “Visitor’s Log” is located in the lounge located on the main floor.

Please be advised that we assign visitors to vacant slips prior to granting permission to remain on the sea wall.

DO NOT TIE UP ON THE AREA OF THE SEA WALL PAINTED YELLOW. THIS AREA IS RESERVED FOR EMERGENCIES, LOADING AND PUMPING OUT. THANK YOU

No Office of the Day (OOD) when you arrive?

Arrival when there is **no** Officer of the Day (OOD) on duty:

- Please speak to any member. They are more than willing to assist you and to confirm you are a member of a Reciprocal Club,
- The member will ask you to sign the “Visitor’s Log” in the lounge and assign you a mooring.

Our Facilities

As a guest/visitor, please respect our facilities and our community. While visiting, you have full access to our common elements. These include:

- Use of washroom & shower facilities;
- Use of the kitchen (upstairs) and the Gas Barbeques (please turn of main gas valve when finished)
- Use of pump –out (with member assistance)

Use of our facilities is a privilege, so PLEASE clean up afterwards. Dishes and utensils are to be washed, dried and put away. Cleaning supplies are located under the sink. Please ensure that you properly dispose of your waste and recyclables. Instructions for waste disposal are located on the bulletin board on the main floor.

You will need to walk – 3 minutes- to Lakeshore Blvd (see map) to catch the **Bathurst Streetcar** which runs north to Bathurst Subway Station. - Most Frequent

Harbourfront Streetcar – 3 minute walk, runs right into Union Station (TTC subway, VIA, GO Trains & Buses).

TTC cash fares are \$2.75 per adult per ride.

TAXIS – usually located at the Island Airport Ferry Dock, 4 minute walk. See bulletin board for telephone numbers.
